Book 1, *Kindling Embers*: Inspector Cassandra McCarthy never thought she'd be raising her two daughters alone, but her husband's unexpected death forced her to find a career. Now working beside a retired Special Operations soldier and veteran fireman, she serves her small North Carolina town, protecting them from hazards they don't understand. She loves what she does and trusts God to provide—until a series of unexplained fires hits too close to home.
